## JUNE GARDENING TIPS:



- Plant out Dahlias & other tender plants.
- Remove tulips that have finished flowering from pots. They can either be re-planted in the garden or dried & stored for next year.
- Check your greenhouse temperature in hot spells. Open vents if you have them or leave the door open by day & provide shading if necessary.
- If your garden is lacking colour in June, lupins, roses, poppies & peonies all flower in June. Look out for local plant sales/stalls where you may pick up a bargain.
- Repeat the sowing of salad crops, such as lettuce. Also stagger the planting of peas, beans etc so you have a steady supply to harvest & not a glut.
- Tie in climbing & rambling roses to keep them under control.

## Parish Council Matters

Due to the May meeting being on 30<sup>th</sup> of the month there will be no minutes this month. The May minutes will appear in the July issue.

### Clarification of item in March Parish Council Minutes

Originally, part of the planning conditions for the Waldrons Estate was that vehicle access would be a one-way system ie. entering the estate OFF of the A3052 using the entrance at the top of the layby and exit OUT of the estate directly on to Parsonage Lane approximately 100 yds up from the A3052. This was a safety measure with the aim to reduce the possibility of an incident, especially if a vehicle was trying to pull into the estate and being blocked by one trying to exit on that fast stretch of road.

This is now being abused and the wheels stops have been inhibited to allow vehicles to exit directly on to the A3052.

## WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A FLOOD

In the event of a flood, there are many authorities available to help. Below outlines who should be contacted for the various types of flooding incidents and emergencies that occur. The local authorities rely on information reported to them to inform any investigations and prioritization of investment. If it is an emergency and there is danger to life as a result of flooding, you should not hesitate to call 999

To report flooding of the highway and blocked drains contact Devon County Council's Highway Customer Service Centre on 0345 155 1004 or visit the Roads and Transport webpage. Office hours are Monday to Friday 8am – 8pm and Saturdays 9am – 1pm. For emergencies outside of these hours call 01392 383329

For any flooding on major trunk roads (the M5, A30, A38, A35 and A303) contact the Highways Agency on 0300 123 5000 (24 hour service)

To report flooding from sewers and water pipes contact South West Water on 0344 346 2020 (24 hour service)

For enquiries about flood warnings contact the Environment Agency's Floodline on 0345 988 1188 (24 hour service)

For general enquiries about Main River or flooding from the sea contact the Environment Agency on 03708 506 506

For all other flooding enquiries contact the Devon County Council Flood Risk Management Team on 0345 155 1015 or email [floodrisk@devon.gov.uk](mailto:floodrisk@devon.gov.uk)

### Preparing for a flood

Please refer to Devon County Council and Environment Agency web pages for advice on what to do before, during and after a flood. In the first instance of flooding and sandbag requests contact your local District or Parish Council to be directed to any local sandbag supplies that may be available.

Flood Alert: Flooding is possible. Be prepared.

Flood Warning: Flooding is expected. Immediate action required.

Severe Flood Warning: Severe flooding. Danger to life


